Badges are good for all three days of the meet.

1. Family Registration - all family members must register. Child's date of birth required and child must be under 18 as of Meet start date. Spouses and children under 18 are not subject to the "one time only" guest rule.

2. Caregiver/Dependent - this category is designed to accommodate the TCA member who requires a caregiver's assistance in order to attend the Meet or for a TCA member who has a relative 18 years of age or older for whom the TCA member must provide constant care and/or supervision. Proof of disability and need for caregiver required when registering. Caregiver must remain with the member at all times and must pick up their badge at the door.

3. Extra Tables - \$27.00 each - Please check your registration form if you wish to be called if a table next to yours or your group of tables is available. Do not send payment for extra table until approved by Diana Hood.

4. RV Registration - All RV's, campers, tents, self-contained vehicles MUST pay the registration fee. **If you sleep on the fairgrounds (vehicles, trailers & tents included) or you have an RV/Bus on the premises during non-show hours, you must pay the \$50.00 fee'** (York Expo Center liability requirement). RV's permitted on site Wed. 9 am - Sat. 6 pm. Enter fairgrounds through Gate 6 (Highland Ave.). Campers may **dry camp** in-line behind the Grandstand after 1PM on Tues. of York week. **Parking your camper in a location other than behind the Grandstand prior to checking in with the RV Chairman is forbidden.** Travel trailers, motor coaches and 5th wheels parked on the black top area must have boards at least 1"x16"x16" under jacks & hitch stands. You must provide a 50' electrical cord, 50' water hose, water Y, and 30 amp adapter for hook-up. RV's arriving on Wed. or Thurs. after 7 pm must dry camp behind the Grandstand (see map) until 8 am the following morning. **Generator use is STRICTLY prohibited between the hours of 10PM & 7AM on the fairgrounds.**

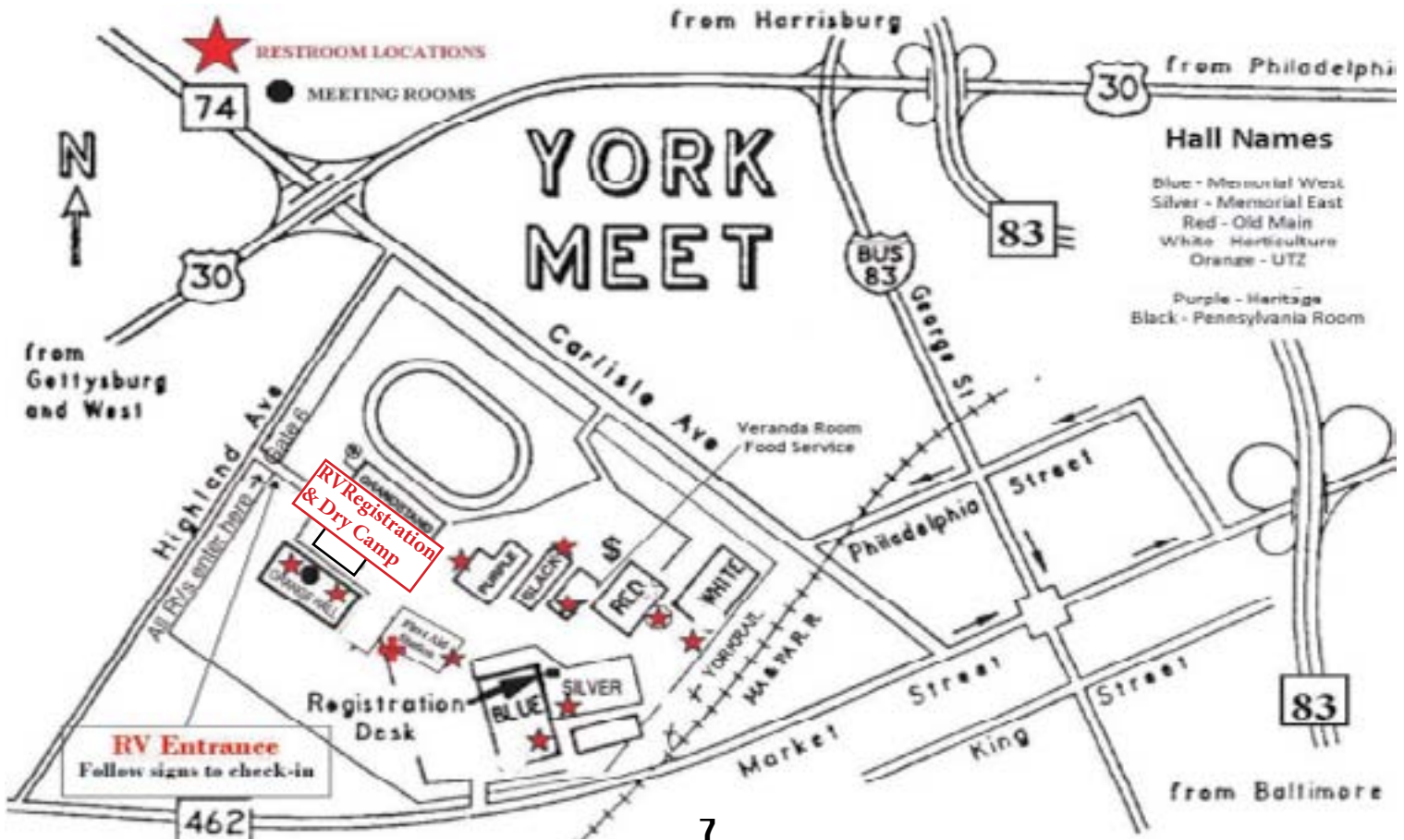

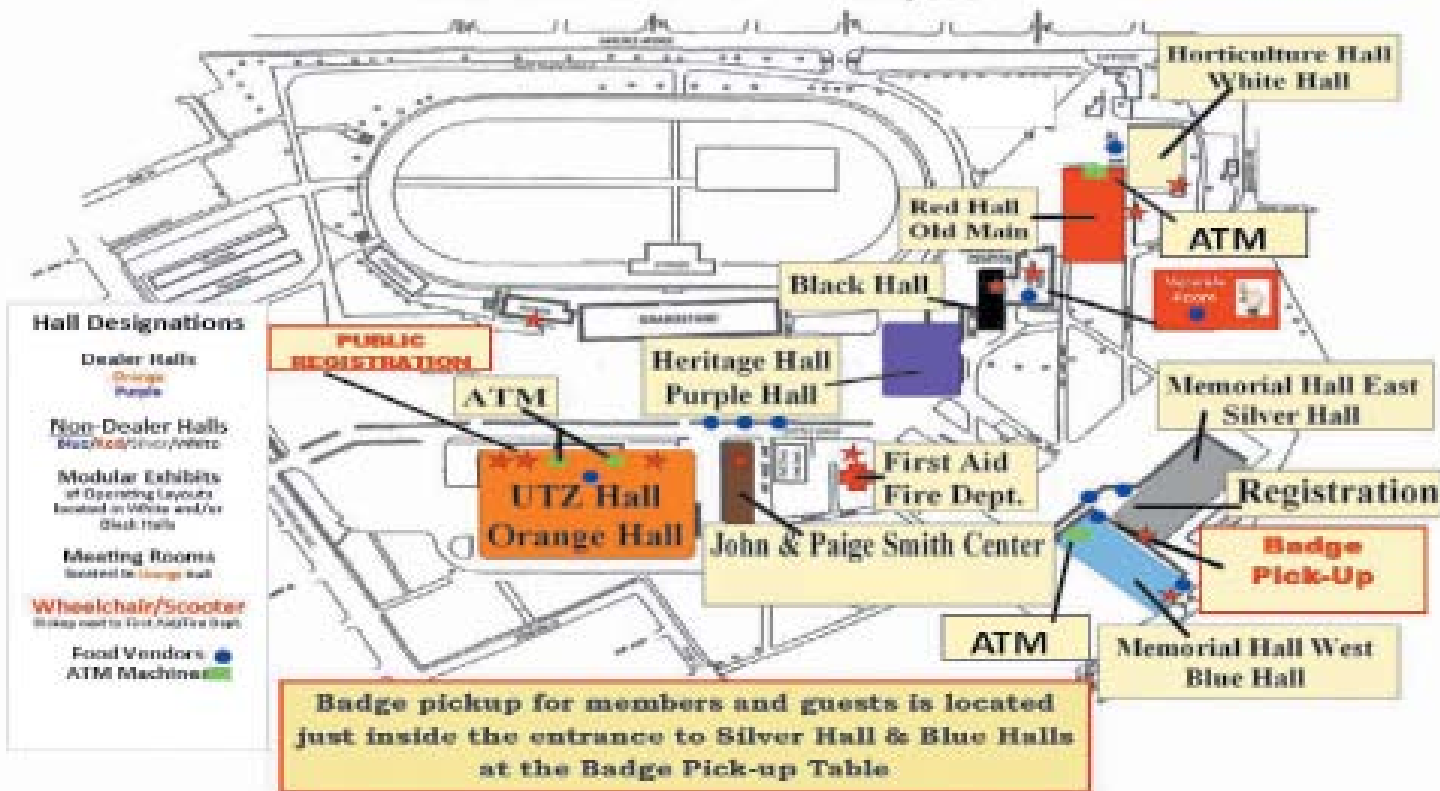
